Resin suppliers to the stretch film industry are implementing the previously announced December 1st increase. They are also strongly indicating there could be additional increases in the first quarter 2012; one has already been announced for January 1st. Rising feedstock costs are given as the primary reason for the increases.

As a result, Western Plastics must implement an increase on stretch film products as follows:

Normal order requirements received on or before December 30, 2011, calling for immediate shipping will be invoiced at current levels. Orders received on or after January 02, 2012 will be billed at the increased price.


