To Our Valued Customers:

Due to rising ethylene monomer feedstock prices, our raw material suppliers have announced a \$.05/lb increase effective November 1<sup>st</sup>. This represents a total of \$.22/lb in resin increases year to date. In addition, resin suppliers have announced a subsequent \$.03/lb increase for December 1<sup>st</sup> that we are continuing to monitor.

As a result of the November 1<sup>st</sup> resin increase, Berry Plastics announces a **6%** increase on all Stretch Film products with any **order placed on or after December 7, 2009 and/or shipping on or after December 21, 2009**. Berry Plastics reserves the right to limit the size of those orders to historical quantities to better serve the anticipated demands of our customers.
